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Hello together,

is there any chance to overcome the transparency of postscript plots.

Making a 3 dimensional plot, the post script output looks bad because of the transparency of the -poly- filled areas. But I do not know in advance, which areas have to be plotted because they can be seen in the completed plot. Otherwise, the same plot in tif format looks bad even if I scale up the window to 2400 x 2400 pixel, especially the font, but the lines, too.
