Jeff writes:

- > I have an image loaded into XROI and have drawn a bunch of ROI's on
- > it. Is there a way to quickly and easily write out a tiff file that
- > has the image and the ROI outlines in it..like you could do if you
- > could do a TVRD on an XROI window?

Here is what I would do. I would define another keyword for XROI, named OWINDOW. I would define it like this:

```
XROI, $
 ..., $
 OWINDOW=oWindow, $
Then, I would call XROI like this:
 IDL> XROI, myimagem OWINDOW=win
After I had drawn my ROI's and before I opened any other
windows, I would do this:
 IDL> win -> GetProperty, Image_Data=theImage
 IDL> Write Tiff, 'myroiimage.tif', Reverse(thelmage,3)
There you go. :-)
