I'm using shared memory to share information between C and IDL. (didn't want to use `call_external` because we could possibly be making frequent changes to the data and I would not want to have to issue a `call_external` command with every change) So I have a structure I'm sharing between IDL and C, but I currently have an IDL version of the structure and an equivalent C version. Ideally we would like to only maintain one version (either in IDL or C) to avoid discrepancies between the 2 versions. Does any one know a way around maintaing two versions of every structure we want to share? Thanks.
