Yeah, crazy mountain-man logic.

My guess is that this is an IDL 1.0 "wouldn't it be cool if" feature, but it is really a dangerous feature that open to accidental abuse.

The wouldn't it be cool aspect is that when one is using the list form of indexing as a 1D lookup table, IDL's behavior automatically does cropping to the table boundaries. Of course, not everybody has 1D lookup tables, and not everybody wants the cropping behavior.
