The main difference between the posted code and the WIDGET_INFO function is that the user is not required to specify the event.top id only the uname of the widget. I wrote this because I kept losing my event.top under a set of various circumstances. Also it did not matter where and when you ran the function. You could run it in a pop-up that had no connection to the main TLB and still find and pass information.

It worked, I thought it was cool, but in the end I took D. Fannings advice and took a closer look at pointers. I still think its a handy little tool though.
