Shell/environment issues always drive me nuts. We do this under tcsh

```
if ($?DISPLAY == 0) then
    if ($?REMOTEHOST) then
        setenv DISPLAY ${REMOTEHOST}:0
    else
        setenv DISPLAY :0
    endif
endif
```

Perhaps that will solve your problem? (We still have issues with
locking the .Xauthority file.)
