for beginners I recommend to stick with CALL_EXTERNAL. Besides the external development guide, you can also look in C:\RSI\IDL61\external\call_external for some examples ready to compile. If you are on Windows and want to use cygwin to compile, look at the recent tech tips on the RSI web site. I bit my nails out on that one and never got it to work until I started using the M\$ C compiler.
