I have acquired an MS-Access databse program from someone else which i need to modify/use. It has quite big files, does a few tens of sql queries and outputs some results. The problems are, it often crashes, works differently on different machines, is split up into n subprograms because of filesize and memoery limitations and is overall a bit of a mess.
