

I am new to this group and to IDL.

What I want is something like this:



I can draw the map with map\_set,/mercator,/grid,/continents and add labels INSIDE the plot with map\_set,/mercator,/grid,/continents,/label and move them around WITHIN the plot with /latlab and /lonlab but I can't work out how to label the axes.

I have tried doing things like:
```

!y.ticks=4

!y.tickv(0)=85.

!y.tickv(1)=50.

!y.tickv(2)=0.

!y.tickv(3) = -50.

!y.tickv(4)=-85.

!y.tickname = ['85', '50','0','-50','-85']

map\_set,/mercator,/grid,/continent

but I get it all squashed up along one edge :-(

If anyone can help me I would be most grateful.

While I am here, I know that there are problems with filling contours which are plotted over a map. Has anyone come up with a solution?
