> things we do is use the save command to save an image and use the restore  
> to bring it back and view it again with the tv command. here is the  
> PROBLEM: it seems almost random that sometimes when we restore the image  
> and tv to display it, it is reversed and sometimes it is not. when it is  
> reversed we must do a reverse(image,2) to bring it back to normal. Why  
> does this seem almost random? how can this be prevented?? thanks for the  
> help we are very confused.

You are probably sometimes running some routine which changes the system variable !ORDER. This controls whether images are displayed top-to-bottom or bottom-to-top. To get consistent results set !ORDER before displaying the image.
