> your own "observer" to the UI to know when a particular ROI has been
> drawn. I never bothered finding out the details due to the relative lack
> of freely available examples of extending iTools. This was reason enough
> to expect that iTools was going to be difficult to tinker with. I
> haven't looked much into iTools, so I may be completely wrong on this one.
