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I tend to feel that due to it's complexity and design, iTools are very difficult to inherit and extend into your own application. For example, you may find that rather than trapping widget events you need to add your own "observer" to the UI to know when a particular ROI has been drawn. I never bothered finding out the details due to the relative lack of freely available examples of extending iTools. This was reason enough to expect that iTools was going to be difficult to tinker with. I haven't looked much into iTools, so I may be completely wrong on this one.

I tend to think that you can probably rip off someone else's ROI drawing tool and make it free-hand if it is not already.
