I wish to plot it in a sequence, so e.g. at time $t=1.2$, vector points North-East with a certain magnitude, time $t=2.3$, vector points North-West, time $t=2.5$, vector points South and so on (times ordinates are unevenly spaced). What is the best way to plot the rotating vectors in a single sequence, of say a couple of hundred ?
