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Has anyone used MAKE_DLL for DLMS? I've used it with CALL_EXTERNAL with no problem, but I'm confused about the DLM search path. Is !MAKE_DLL.COMPILE_DIRECTORY included on it by default? It seems not. If so, what's the typical way people are discovering and loading DLMS that end up in ~/.idl/idl_6_X_X_linux_x86_m32_f64/compile_dir or the like? I suppose you can reference it directly with DLM_REGISTER, but isn't that defeating the purpose?
