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Marc Schellens wrote:

> IDL> print,!version
> { x86 linux unix linux 6.0 Jun 27 2003    32    64}
> IDL> b=bindgen(64)
> IDL> byteorder,b,/sswap,/l64swap
> Floating exception
```

I get the same with

```
{ x86 linux unix linux 6.1 Jul 14 2004    32    64}
```

but if I don't use the /l64swap option everything is fine. Is it forcing IDL to use a 64bit command on a 32bit os?
