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Wonderful! Works in idl 6.1 on SunOS 5.9. The images occasionally look a bit silly because annotation colors are slipped into the look up table (LUT). However, I think it is quite a reasonable price to pay for the increase in performance. I tried setting 'device, decomposed=0' and 'device, decomposed=1' but it doesn't make any difference.

I wouldn't mind seeing 'Save window as DICOM' or perhaps even 'Send window to PACS' in the file menu. I've been using wrappers to spawn the DICOM Toolkit (DCMTK) for a while now. Amongst many other things DCMTK allows you to send/recieve images using command line executables. I've also got a DICOM writer which is just a logical extention of dicom_writer.pro.
