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I'm trying to import sound samples into the Macintosh version of IDL to perform some simple frequency domain filtering. Currently, I do this by using a freeware utility called "SoundHandle" to convert my sound samples (in various formats such as AIFF and System 7 sounds) into a text file and then importing these text files into IDL with a very simple procedure.

The problem is that SoundHandle takes forever to perform the conversions. I was wondering whether anyone has written code to import Macintosh AIFFs into IDL arrays. If so, can I use your code? The work I'm doing is non-commercial and is actually the final project for a graduate class in digital image processing and multimedia.

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
