I hope it is not but rather a feature of the program you use.

I used Windows XP for that to find out what elements of PostScript are used by IDL. The IDL plotting devices (PS is one of them) does not depend on the operating system, so I'm pretty sure that if IDL translates TV into the PS image operator (using Windows XP) it will do so using OSX.

I tried a couple of PS interpreters to find how they in turn handle the image operator and all of them filled the rectangles specified by image with constant color. No interpolation occured.
