I can confirm it using your pdf and I can also see it in other images I've created at very high zooms. It's nothing you're doing wrong that I can see.

Maybe if you tried upsampling the array you use within IDL, so that each 'pixel' in the plot is blown up to an n by n grid all of the same colour? That may persuade OS X to at least use narrow regions to interpolate over.
