>> 'a': print,'joy!'

>> 'b' OR 'c': print,'ouch!'

>> ELSE: print, '??'

>> ENDCASE

>>

>> obviously this syntax doesn't works

Unless you have your heart really set on using the CASE you could use a SWITCH instead of a CASE.

Example:

SWITCH str OF
```

  'a' : BEGIN
```

```
    print,'joy!'
```

```
    BREAK
```

```
  END
```

```
  'b' :
```

```
  'c' : BEGIN
```

```
    print, 'ouch!'
```

```
    BREAK
```

```
  END
```

```
  ELSE : print, '??'
```

```
ENDSWITCH
```
