The various problems with HDF are what led me to use netCDF. Not only are they written "by scientists for scientists" but much of the underpinnings of the format appear to have been written by "computer scientists rather than scientists." Issues with the format aside, I just like the fact that there are *stable, working* netCDF access routines in IDL, Java, C, Perl, Python, etc. In fact, whenever I have to work with HDF, the first thing I usually do is write a small conversion program that converts the file to netCDF and then I work with it from there. :-)
