and I note that the little "+/-" icons next to directories don't work. That is, the only way I can look at the contents of a subdirectory is enter it via a double-click. The little manila-folder subdirectory icons do open and close when I single-click the "+/-" bitties, but there is no display of files. (Does this explanation even make sense?)
