Robert> % Structures can't have anonymous structure members

Robert> % Execution halted at \$MAIN\$.

As was pointed out in someone else's post, the use of anonymous structure members (along with the CREATE_STRUCT routine) is a new addition as of IDL Version 3.6 (see the ./notes/rel_note.doc in the IDL distribution). We have postscript versions of the 3.6 manuals and the appropriate changes are present in Chapter 7.
