Patrick Dillmann writes:

- > I have a question about maximize a minimized GUI.
- > After minimized a SubGUI, which has been started from my MainGUI, e.g.
- > from a pull-down menu or a button, is it possible to maximize the
- > SubGUI when I press the button in the MainGUI again instead of open a
- > new SubGUI?

Depending upon how you have written this application, XREGISTERED might give you this functionality directly. If not, XREGISTERED will probably give you the information you need to do it. But if you *\*still\** have no joy, then you can use WIDGET\_INFO to see if the subGUI TLB is realized (REALIZED keyword), or valid (VALID\_ID keyword). If so, then maximize rather than recreate.
