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The method depends on the size of those images. For large images, it is impossible to read the whole image into memory, which makes it more difficult to do especially when the resulting image is not in BSQ format. In this case, I think using ASSOC can be a good choice. To get a BSQ multi-band image, you can just read and write images one-by-one. If single image is too large to read as a whole, then you should read a small part (say, one line) of the image repeatedly.
