StrSplit was introduced in IDL 5.3, so that is the reason for this error.

The other errors are inexplicable to me. Sorry. :-(

I guess this could be caused by a mixture of new and old programs, or possibly multiple copies in your path, something odd like that. But I have no other reports of the program not working.
