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This is an example to show how I work with IDLdoc.

Suppose my project directory is:

```
MyProject
|-- main.pro
|
|---Subdir1
| |--File1.pro

|--Doc
    |--API_doc(subdir)
    |--idldoc (subdir)
```

I want to create the API documentation for all *.pro files of my project and put it into API_doc subdirectory.

I have put all IDLdoc files into 'idldoc' subdirectory (idldoc.sav, idldoc.css, etc). Then I have created a file called "gendoc" (Generate documentation :)) like this:

```
PRO gendoc
    idldoc, root='../..', $
        output='../api', $
        title='GenRad 2.0', $
        subtitle='GRAHI';, $
        ;footer='../foot.html'
END
```

The root directory of my project is "two levels up" (root='../..'). I want to put the HTML generated files into API_doc subdirectory (in this case: output='../API_doc'). Also I want my own title and subtitle :)

The only problem I have found is with "footer" keyword. I don't know if I have created a bad foot.html but if I include this option the resulting overview.html file is not correct :(

Well, to generate the documentation just go into the MyProject/Doc/idldoc directory and execute "gendoc".
