Hello,

back in the times of 5.6 I wrote a program which accepts input from /dev/stdin. I used the on\_ioerror command to test the end of the input, i.e. a ^D at the prompt yielded the !error\_state.code of -236 which was used to terminate the input. I noticed that this piece of software did not work anymore with IDL 6.1. The reason is that the error\_state codes obviously differ: EOF is now -265. Can a brave soul point me to the section of the documentation where these codes are summarized (as well as the changes). I have not found that yet.
