> We've just had IDL4.0 installed, and things appear rather
> different now :-). In particular, the cluster-mean userlib
> KMEANS appears to have disappeared. Does anyone know if this is
> actually the case, or if our installation has just stuffed up?
> If it has gone, is there a straightforward replacement? I've
> been going through the new online manual, and can't find a thing
> about it.

It appears RSI has done some renaming of routines. The function formerly known as CHI_SQR1 is now CHISQR_PDF, for example.

Take a look at the "IDL Statistics Library Revisions" page in HyperHelp under "What's New in IDL v4", then check the "obsolete" directory (which is now in the default !PATH under v4.)

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
