> Is there some easy, and safe for IDL 5.x, way to check if
> one is in the VM environment? It seems like there should
> be a system variable that indicates the environment
> but I didn't see it mentioned in the documentation I've seen.

You can use the `lmgr()` function, e.g. `lmgr(/VM)` returns 1 if the current session is using a VM license, and there are many other options.

I am a little confused about the reference to IDL 5.x though, since I thought the VM wasn't introduced until V6.0. (So if you are running V5.x then you know it is not a VM license...) --Wayne
