- > fun with "speedbar", which is an Emacs way to browse files, and the
- > contents of files (like routines) in a sidebar. I've never use the
- > project feature; I tend to organize by directory.

By the way, Speedbar can be turned on by default, or with Tools->Display Speedbar in the Emacs menu. Middle click on things (or use arrows and return). I also use "iMenu" bound to Shift-Right-Click, to popup a list of routines in my file (see the IDLWAVE screenshots at idlwave.org).
