Here is what I just did to create a PDF file directly from IDL on my Windows machine:

(1) Downloaded the \*free\* CutePDF Writer software from the fine folks at Globalscape. (Great FTP software, too!)

(2) Typed the following commands in IDL:

IDL> set\_plot, 'printer' IDL> a=dialog printersetup()

At this point I selected the CutePDF Writer from my list of printers.

IDL> Plot, findgen(11) IDL> Device, /Close

Whala! A PDF document with my graphics was created! Easy, easy, easy!!
