: part of the default font table if one knows how to use the ISO  
: encoding to specify the character, which unfortunately I don't and can't  
: figure out from the documentation.

This probably isn't the easiest way to do it, but I find it useful:  
you can use string(194b) - I set it up in my idlstartup as  
angst=string(194b). Works on UNIX and VAX Alpha.
