> nice to have some sort of mechanism to handle the other 5%. Timers and  
> socket I/O come to mind.

Socket I/O is exactly our problem. We use a timer to continuously (actually frequently rather than continuously) read from a socket to implement a listening socket. But there are many problems with that, like IDL not reacting while it tries to read (looks like crashed).

I guess IDL is just made for data analysis and not instrument control which involves interaction with device drivers and the OS on a deeper level :-).
