You need the fsf-compat package to be compatible with FSF Emacs and to get IDLWAVE to run properly. You can either get that from a sumo emacs, or install the package separately, available where you got XEmacs. This is the same issue as the "Symbol's function is void: overlayp" XEmacs error.

I've made the website and INSTALL file more explicit since there seems to be a large number of XEmacs distributions without fsf-compat bundled these days. I also update the FAQ with this error.
