Hi group,

I have a little problem with my idlwave-mode.

I have defined on my .bashrc and .bash\_profile file the IDL\_PATH environment variable to point IDL directories and another personal directory with some routines.

The problem is:

- If I open a GNOME-terminal and execute emacs (into X) then all is ok.
- I can execute the programs that execute my personal routines.
- If I execute Emcas directly from a launcher icon the !PATH variable not contains my personal directory.

Any idea, thanks.
