Let me add one little addendum to this. You should be able to set the values you want by using the TICKVALUES and TICKTEXT as keywords as Ben explained. These properties along with the other TICK\* keywords should be enough for most people. However, there have been times when I've needed to do additional things with the axis that couldn't be done through the interface in IDLgrColorbar. Since then I've always been in the habit of having both an IDLgrColorbar and IDLgrAxis.
