But it seems that I can't do this in ENVI. Say my image is 512*512, I can only export it as a 512*512 image, I can't change the dimensions. I know a little bit IDL (direct graphics), so I'm thinking maybe I could try to do a program. Is it possible to use different colors or color tables to display different parts of an image? My image includes 3 parts: ocean (=999), land(=900), ROIs on land (=0~100). I'd like my ocean to be white, land to be yellow, and ROIs to be displayed using the Blue-red color table. I've been trying for 3 hours with no luck. Could you give me some hints or at least tell me is it possible with IDL direct graphics?
