> Thanks, Rick. Paint Shop could be used to check the dpi of any image.
> The problem is the images I'm preparing will be published in a journal,
> and it has strick length limit, so your suggestion to export a larger
> image won't work in my case.

Sure it will.

O.K. I was wrong about the JPEG header business (I just played around with photoshop and JPEGs can store dpi info), but you still can export to a larger size then load it into Paint Shop and "fix" it.

Say you want a 2" x 2" image @ 300dpi. Export a 600 x 600 image from ENVI. Load it into your paint program and change the DPI to 300 while at the same time changing the print size to 2" x 2" (this preserves the pixel dimensions so no resampling occurs). Save it.

Now you have a 2" x 2" JPEG image at 300dpi.
