In iplot, a way to do this (perhaps there is an easier way I am not aware of), is by inserting a new dataspace.
Plot the first series, e.g. iplot,a then in iplot click on edit->insert new dataspace.
Type at the commandline iplot,b,/overplot.
Then in iplot, the relevant axes can be hidden, by double clicking on the data. So you leave axes 1 and 3 for the first set and axes 2 and 4 for the second dataset.
