On Thu, 28 Jul 2005, Mathieu Malaterre wrote:

- > 1. Even executing xinstall.sh does not work unless you copy the cdrom
- > tree to another directory

if you mount the cdrom through a desktop icon, the underlying mount command usually has the noexec flag, so xinstall.sh will not run.

solution: (from SuSE experience, but may be relevant to Debian, too):

- use 'source xinstall.sh' (tcsh) or '. xinstall.sh' (bash) this will not run xinstall.sh directly, but asks the shell to run it

or

 mount manually the CD (as root), eg. mount /dev/cdrom /mnt, then /mnt/xinstall.sh should run
