I have one satellite image (geoTIFF) and a corresponding vector layer.
I
was able to overlay the vector layer onto the image using OO IDL.
Now I am interested in *swiping* the vector layer on the Image display
(similar to the ENVI's swipe functionality, which by the way only
supports raster over raster.)

I understand that I have to create two layers one containing the Image
which would remain static and the second layer, containing the vector,
which would be *swiping* over the Image layer when the mouse is dragged
across the window (there by providing an progressive overlaying of
vectors).

I am sure someone must have done this in IDL.

I would be grateful if someone would give pointers on how to achieve
this using objects.

I would appreciate it if someone would point out or provide algorithm
for swiping.
