Is anyone else having problems with CURSOR? I have never seen this behavior before, and I have no idea if it is an IDL or an OS issue. I am running IDL 6.1 on Mac OS X 10.4.2.

If I run this program:

PRO TEST_CURSOR PLOT, FINDGEN(5) CURSOR, x, y, /DATA PRINT, x, y END

it opens an X window and draws the graph. I click on the graphics window to change keyboard focus. Clicking in the window has no effect. I click back to my terminal window and interrupt execution with control-C. Moving the mouse back to the graphic window produces an event just as the mouse enters the window (see below).

This behavior renders CURSOR completely non-functional.
