I've been doing this a LONG time, but today I saw this on a PC, too. What in the world have I been paying attention to!? RETALL has *never* failed me, ever! I feel like I'm in some kind of time warp... :-(

Here is another thing today that surprised me. Two people in the class have new Mac laptops. I have a little program, PickColorName, that displays 96 small draw widgets and fills them with a color with Polyfill. Colors appears instantaneously on a Windows PC. But on the Macs (both of them) the draw widgets appear all in black, then a second or so later the colors appear. It is VERY slow.

I was shocked, really. I hear so much about how Macs are perfect for graphics applications, but this looked more like the VAX VMS workstations I learned IDL on 20 years ago. Any ideas about why this happens? One of the Mac users told me it is common with some of her applications, too.
