hi Dick,

You're almost there. As you can see the little code snippet is testing for the existence of a file named /tmp/.X?-lock which is written by X11.app. This works when the shell is started after X11. (I choose to start X11 at login using the GUI in Preferences->Accounts->...

Hard coding

```
setenv DISPLAY ":0.0"
```

probably works 99% of the time (and can be done before X11 starts), but I saw someone else doing it this way so I followed suit. :)

Regarding middle paste, I don't know if Terminal.app can be configured that way or not. I recommend iTerm at <http://iterm.sourceforge.net> which definitely can.

I think I use Monaco in iTerm. Now if I could just get a nice looking font in the text editor I'm test-driving, jedit ...
