Hi Jeff,

I am most probably getting something wrong here, but if I assume that each tiff file represents one x/y layer, then rotating about the z axis would just mean that you have to rotate each individual file, which you could (on a Unix machine) easily do with e.g. convert without bothering IDL.

However, I guess there is more to it, so I'd appreciate if you could clarify the problem with e.g. a 2x2x3 example.
