## Dear All,

I want to call the IDL function from the C. I am using RedHat Linux 9.0 and IDL 6.2. I was trying to run the example program Calltest.c provided along with the IDL distribution CD, but was not able to run the program. The details of the error and the command to compile the Calltest.c on linux are given below.

make IDLDIR=\$IDL\_DIR calltest gcc -l/usr/local/rsi/idl\_6.2/external/include -o calltest /usr/local/rsi/idl\_6.2/external/callable/calltest.c -L/usr/local/rsi/idl\_6.2/bin/bin.linux.x86 -lidl -WI,-rpath,. -WI,-rpath /usr/local/rsi/idl\_6.2/bin/bin.linux.x86 /usr/X11R6/lib/libXm.so.3 -IXp -L/usr/X11R6/lib -IXpm -IXext -IXt -ISM -IICE -IX11 -ldl -Itermcap -Irt -Im -Ipthread

## The error issued is:

/usr/bin/ld: cannot find -IXp collect2: ld returned 1 exit status

make: \*\*\* [calltest] Error 1
