Benjamin,

There's no way to set a group leader for an iTool. However, to close an iTool programatically you can use either the `itDelete` or `itReset` commands.

`itDelete` will close a single tool. So, for example:

```
IDL> iplot,findgen(10),IDENTIFIER=idPlot
```

```
IDL> itDelete, idPlot
```

`itReset` will reset the entire iTools system, so it's useful if you want to close multiple tool windows at once.

Note that there are some iTools dialogs which are tool-independent (like the Macro Editor and Style Editor windows), and if these are open, they won't be closed after calling `itDelete`. To close those you have to use `itReset`.
