Other folk have answered the technical query better than I could, but having just trod a very similar path (including falling foul of /NO_COPY wiping state variables while trying to create modal dialogs) I can sympathise.

However, beyond sympathy I can pass on the following advice, which I have had here, and from both RSI UK and RSI Central tech support: do not use the GUI builder aside from your very first steps in Widget programming because it makes code that is a horror show (yes, that sentiment came from RSI's own tech support people).

Thanks to the good folk here and at RSI and a fair bit of RTFM my first widget program is now pretty much done and dusted (with modal dialogs too!), I /almost/ know just what's going on, and the code is a *lot* more understandable than the mince that came out of the code generator!
