How are you or the OP locating the axis in the x direction? You're not under the illusion that you can do this with the POSITION keyword are you? Oh no. For an X/Y/Z axis the 0/1/2nd element of POSITION is ignored.

Incidentally, LABEL_DATE is evil; the C() formats are much better, and not *that* hard to construct.
